

THE IDAHO FOODBANK POPP PARTNER AGREEMENT

The Idaho Foodbank and the Partner Agency _____ have agreed that the Partner Agency may purchase product through the Power of Purchase Program (POPP). This program is optional and is offered as an alternative procurement process for food products. When deciding whether to participate, partners should consider the effectiveness of current local systems for purchasing products. Partners are under no obligation to participate.

The Partner may purchase POPP products from The Idaho Foodbank to be used to serve those who seek assistance from the Partner for free emergency food. The Partner may never sell to or share the POPP product with any other agency or entity, nor may they charge a fee for the food to the end recipient.

An authorized partner agency representative must sign this agreement. Please keep a copy for your own files, and return the original to us at:

Credit Terms:

POPP purchases will be invoiced on the same monthly cycle as delivery fees and value-added product (VAP) fees and will share the same credit terms. Please contact our Accounting Office if you have questions regarding billing at 208-577-2695.

A current ST-101, Sales Tax Resale or Exemption Certificate will be required from all exempt POPP partners. The Idaho Foodbank is required by the Idaho State Tax Commission to collect sales tax on POPP product sold to non-exempt partner agencies.

I understand that I may purchase product through the Power of Purchase Program (POPP), but am under no obligation to do so. Should I choose to purchase POPP products, I will agree to the credit terms as outlined to me by The Idaho Foodbank.
